When you have completed the PRINCE2 Foundation e-learning course, you should be ready to start preparing for the Foundation Level exam.

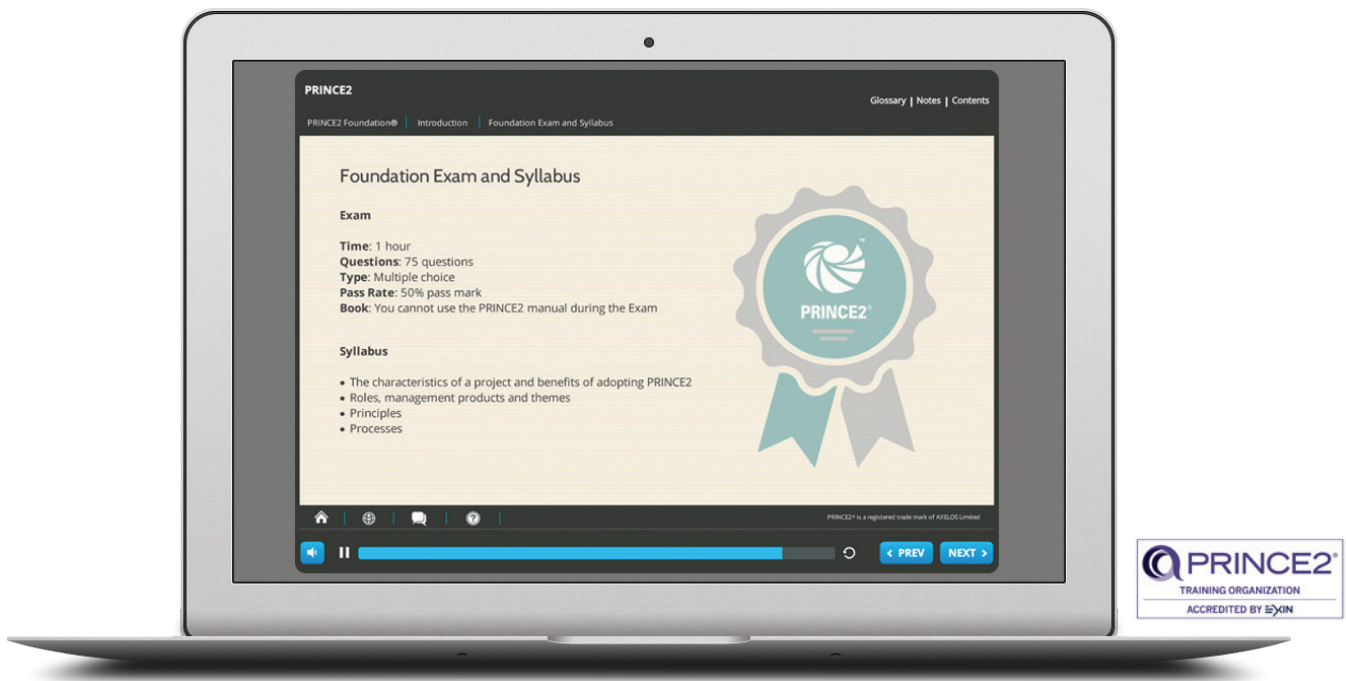
The exam is a closed-book exam, consisting of 70 multiple-choice questions, of which you need to get half correct to pass. There is a time limit of 60 minutes.

It can be taken online at a place and time that suits you, whilst recording the exam session through your webcam and microphone using *EXIN Anywhere*.

The recorded video and audio is then retrospectively reviewed by proctors to check for compliance to exam guidelines. You will receive the final result within 10 days.
